The modern lines of the 24 were a departure for Freeman in the late 1970s. This example features a Perkins 4.108 diesel and a full soft top enabling navigation beneath lower bridges.

Designed as a river and estuary motor cruiser, with a moderate V hull and fixed keel to aid manoeuvrability, Also includes a current licence for the Great Ouse till Dec 2022. BSS Certificate until November 23.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Fore cabin has 2 berths with storage under, shelving either side and hatch to deck above. Hanging locker to port, laminate floor. Main saloon has table dinette to port, table drops to form double berth, storage under. Access to engine under aft seating, Sea toilet and galley to starboard.

ENGINE

Powered by a single Perkins 4.108 four cylinder diesel engine which provides propulsion direct to the propeller via a gearbox and shaft.

2 x 12 volt batteries.

12v & 240v domestic electrics, sockets & lighting, 212v switch panel, battery charger, hot water calorifier, fresh water pump, 230v fridge, navigation lights, horn, windscreen wiper, stainless steel grab rails,
